FIRST STEPS AND GOALS

The ANALYST Project develops a structured European learning pathway to strengthen skills in intelligence analysis, strategic planning and decision-making across sectors.

- European Needs Assessment: transnational study to assess existing intelligence analysis models, skills gaps and needs across Europe
- Professional Profile Development: the consortium defines a Professional Profile for Research and Intelligence Analysts with key competences aligned with labour market
- Training Programme Design: a tailored training programme is developed, combining academic knowledge and practical tools
- MOOC – Online Learning: a MOOC (Massive Open Online Course) offers accessible, high-quality training resources to learners
- Summer School: an international Summer School provides in-person training, peer learning and hands-on exercises
- Internship Programme: participants gain practical experience through internships, connecting training outcomes with real-world professional environments.
- European Network & Conference: an International Conference in Bruxelles fostering dialogue among professionals and contributing to policy debate.

NEXT STEP: BUILDING THE NETWORK

Last objective of the project is now to create a functional **“European Corporate Intelligence Community Network” (CICN)** that connects corporate intelligence and security practitioners, national professionals’ associations, academic/training institutions and relevant EU/institutional actors, fostering collaborative intelligence capacity, pan-European perspective, standardisation of competencies and knowledge sharing.



HOW?

EUROPEAN CORPORATE INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY NETWORKS’ OBJECTIVES

- Build a governance structure (steering board, working groups) for the CICN under the umbrella of ANALYST or its successor.
- Map and engage key stakeholders (institutional, corporate, associations) across EU member states.
- Develop a portal/platform (digital hub) for exchange of intelligence-related resources, training modules, case-studies, events, community forums.
- Launch pilot national chapters or partner associations in at least 6 EU member states (covering Western, Northern, Eastern, Southern Europe) by one year.
- Standardise a “corporate intelligence analyst” competency profile (leveraging ANALYST job-profile output) and promote pan-European certification or recognition.
- Organise an annual European Corporate Intelligence Conference bringing practitioners, associations, academics.
- Facilitate private-public intelligence dialogues: engage corporate intelligence with European institutional intelligence/oversight bodies, policy makers.
