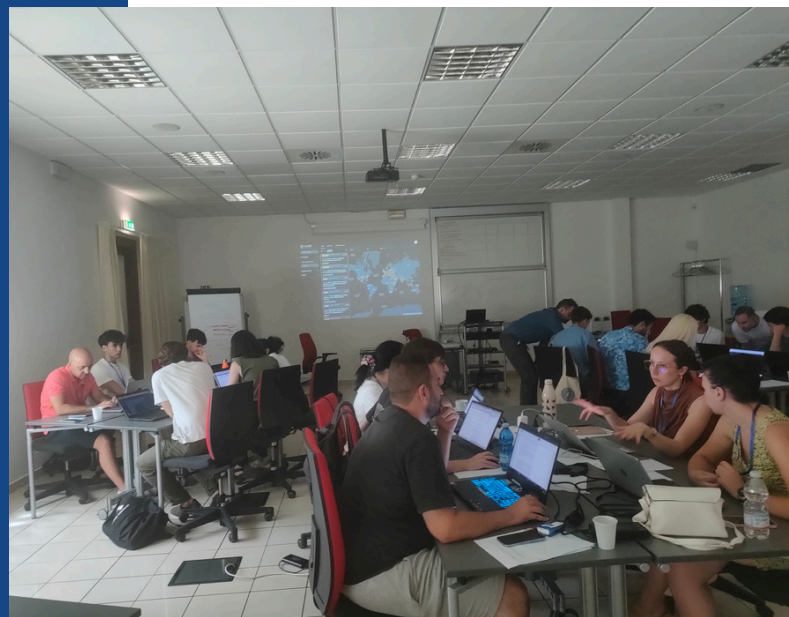

Summer School in Volterra: Simulating Tomorrow's Challenges

From July 7 to 11, the SIAF training center in Volterra hosted the 5-day Summer School, bringing together Italian, Greek, and Spanish participants to work in multinational teams. Acting as intelligence units advising a company investing in the Arctic region, participants tackled geopolitical scenarios, classified risks, and made data-driven decisions – all under expert guidance from consortium trainers. The most promising participants will now have the opportunity to continue their journey with internships starting in September.

4th Transnational Project Meeting & What's Next

While participants tackled intelligence scenarios, project partners gathered in Volterra for the 4th Transnational Project Meeting to evaluate progress and coordinate final steps. The consortium is now preparing for two major milestones: the start of the internship programme and the International ANALYST Conference, which will take place in Brussels in late November. This event will bring together experts, policymakers, and future analysts to shape the future of intelligence education in Europe.
